Entries must be made by centres between 01 September and 30 September 2022. NO entries will be accepted after 18:00 BST on 30 September 2022.

This registration form should NOT be returned to Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing but should be handed to your test centre.

All entries must be made by registered centres via the Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing Entries Extranet.

Centre Examinations Officers wishing to make changes to an entry should NOT make a new entry, as this may cause a delay in the processing of results. Instead, the existing entry should be edited.
