

Planning a gap year



Taking a year out of studying to do something else can do wonders for your skils, confidence and CV. Many people take a gap year before starting college or university, but you could take one at any time.

Gap years: the possibilities

In your gap year, you could do anything:

- volunteer abroad
- do some work experience in the UK to build up your skills.
- · see a bit of the world

Taking a gap year is a good way of gaining more experiences before going on to further study at university.

It could be your first time away from school or college with no teachers or assignments to worry about. If you choose to work, it might be the first time you've worked full-time. Whatever you do, taking a gap year could be a good way to help your confidence and to become more independent before university.

- Volunteering if you're between 14 and 19
- Voluntary work placements
- Getting into university and higher education (education and learning section)

Boost your career prospects

Even if getting a job seems a long way off, taking a gap year can also look good on your CV. Potential employers see that you have spent time broadening your horizons and learning new skills.

Volunteering for an industry or organisation you would like to get into in the future shows employers that you are dedicated to

If you want to return to college or university, a gap year shows that you are committed to your education. You may find that you approach learning in a different way after a year out.

International applicants

If you are applying from outside the UK or EU, whatever your nationality, you need to be aware of the three application deadlines, although many universities and colleges will consider your application up until 30 June. This does not apply to applications for the universities of Oxford and Cambridge, courses in medicine, dentistry, veterinary medicine or veterinary science. For all of these, you must apply by 15 October.

Universities and colleges do not guarantee to consider applications they receive after 15 January, and some popular courses may not have vacancies after that date. Please check with individual universities and colleges if you are not sure. You are advised to apply as party as possible

Remember to allow enough time for entry clearance or immigration; also travel and accommodation arrangements, which can take longer during the summer when immigration departments are busy.

If you think you may be assessed as a 'home' student (UK or EU) for tuition fees, you should apply by the relevant deadline at the top of the page.

Several countries require their citizens to complete mandatory military or national service. If this affects you, check with universities and colleges in advance to discuss when you should apply. You can defer through UCAS for a maximum of one year. It would be useful to include information on your military or national service in your personal statement.

Taking a year out?

If you want to take a year out before starting your course, check with your universities and colleges that they will accept a deferred entry application. If you apply for deferred entry in 2013, you must still apply by the relevant deadline above, and meet the conditions of any offers by 31 August 2012. If you accept a place starting in 2013, you can't reapply through us in the same cycle, unless your original application is withdrawn.

You can only send us one application in each year's application cycle. If you send a second application, it will be cancelled and you will not receive a refund.


