Session: Improving students' listening skills

Background: Listening is the basis of foreign language learning and the precursor to speaking. Listening

has also assumed more importance in language tests in Japan recently. This session will look at practical classroom activities which help to improve students' listening and

pronunciation skills.

Learning aims: Teachers will learn how to:

 help students switch on their brains for listening by using purposeful listening strategies

help students make use of tables and graphic organisers when listening

help students perceive familiar words in the stream of speech.

• give clear, effective explanations of meaning, spelling and pronunciation

help students to remember new words more efficiently

• help students recycle the vocabulary they learn flexibly for communication.
